Located inside the Main Inn

Agnes' Room T

Frances' Room T
The morning sun brightens this spacious room through triple French windows which provide a grand overview of gardens and woods. King or twin iron and brass beds.
Frances is the wife of John Spicer.

Jessie's Room T
An ivory room where you can enjoy a spectacular view of the lake from the octagonal tower. A walnut spool bed adds to the special quality of this room.
Jessie is the daughter of John Spicer.

Mason's Room W
A spacious room in majestic gold and maroon, high over the lake. This room features a massive carved four poster mahogany bed.
Mason is the son of John Spicer.

Ruth's Room T
A cozy ivory room with a balcony overlooking the lake, it is furnished with white iron and brass bed. Sunsets are quite spectacular from this room.
Ruth is John Spicer's daughter.

Russel's Room T
Lake, yard and woods are all viewed from six windows. Warm stained wainscoting is complemented with soft yellow curtains and gold accents.
Russel is John Spicer's son.

Is decorated with garnet walls and Navajo white fireplace. A table and chairs at the window provides a special place for games or dining.

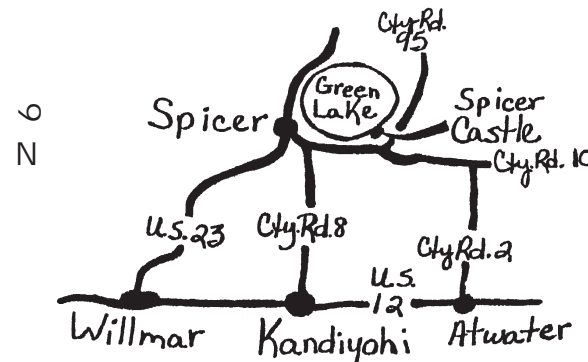

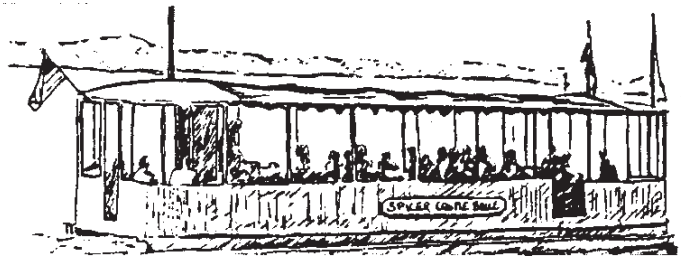
## MURDER MYSTERY

**Guest Rooms:** Rates are for two guests per room per night, tax not included. All guest rooms are air conditioned.

**Confirmations:** To guarantee your reservation we require a deposit of 25% of one night's room rate. For your convenience we accept major credit cards or personal checks and, we provide a confirmation number.

**Cancellations:** We are a small family owned Inn and rely on our advance bookings. For a refund on cancellations we require a \$20 processing fee per room, per night with a 7 day notice. Thirty day notice for three or more room reservations. After that time you will be charged for the room (this also applies to Gift Certificate reservations). We will provide you with a cancellation number. There are no cancellations due to weather.

**Phone:** We provide phone service in our office during normal business hours.

**Check-In:** Is anytime after 4:00 p.m. If you expect to arrive after 8:00 p.m., please let us know.
